The Mathematical Institute of the Academy of Sciences, the Faculty of Mathematics and Physics of the Charles University, the Institute of Computer Science of the Academy of Sciences and the Union of Czech Mathematicians and Physicists, in cooperation with the Patriae Foundation, will organize a Prague Mathematical Conference in July 1996.

The aim of the conference is to bring together people from different disciplines who work in the fields of ordinary and partial differential equations, linear algebra, and functional analysis and people who are interested in the numerical treatment of problems from these fields and their applications.

Invited lectures will be given in honor of Professor Ivo Babuška, Professor Miroslav Fiedler, Professor Jaroslav Kurzweil, and Professor Vlastimil Pták, who laid the foundations of several branches of modern mathematics, on the occasion of their 70th birthdays.

The five-day program will consist of invited lectures, short communications in parallel sessions, and poster sessions. The Organizing Committee headed by K. Segeth will distribute further information in the spring of 1995.
